Terrorism, cyber-attack, WMD proliferation, anti ship ballistic missiles...

Criminal / Illegal

 Piracy, drugs, human trafficking, mass migration, smuggling, marine exploitation...

Toxic waste, dumping, overfishing...




Sharing Solutions: MDA Registry

 Internet-accessible web service created to improve awareness of MDA tools, information products, and data services.


New Capability: Cognitive Analytics Pilot

Why Cognitive Analytics?

- Ability to leverage data that is too complex, dynamic, and vast for traditional analysis
- Speeds integration and understanding of complex information

Impact for Maritime Community

- ZERO COST to the customer!






